#### You don't need...


- \* a social media picture with Santa to be a great parent;



#### Safe savings with MCU

Your savings with MCU are fully covered by the Financial Services Compensation Scheme (FSCS). This means that the FSCS can pay you compensation if your financial services provider fails - including credit unions.

An eligible depositor is protected up to £85,000 per person per provider. This limit relates to the combined amount in all of a member's accounts with the same provider.
