We know that many of our members are going to be struggling to make ends meet this Christmas. It is always an expensive time of year, and can often also be very stressful, especially for families, with competing demands on our time and our pockets, but this year it is going to be especially difficult for many due to the massive rise in energy prices and the general cost of living. The price of everything has gone up except wages and benefits which have not increased in line with prices for most of us. With no let up in sight we will all have to find a way to cope and to help each other through the winter, which I know is going to be easier said than done.

One of the first things to check is whether you are getting everything you are entitled to - in Greater Manchester alone there is over £70million of unclaimed Pension Credits, plus millions more of other benefits. There is a **benefits calculator** on our website where you can check what you may be entitled to. It might just be worth checking as your circumstances may have changed and you might now be caring for someone and be entitled to Carers' Allowance for example.

Local councils are doing what they can to help by providing Hardship payments, lots of information on where to get help and support, and warm spaces where you can spend some time with others in your community and stay warm. It's actually starting to feel like war time when everyone pulls together because we're all in the same boat! Have a read of our <u>blog</u> which provides helpful hints and tips on saving money and energy. There's also lots of useful information on the <u>StepChange</u> website so please do have a look.

As I said earlier in the year, as a member you are part of our credit union family, and we will do everything we can to help you get through this, so please talk to us at the earliest opportunity if you are struggling to repay your loan.
